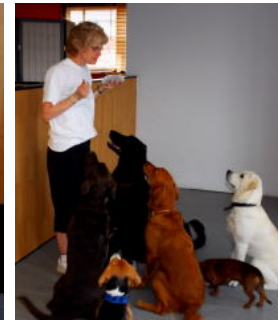
Our First annual HALLOWEEN PARTY!!

With the New Year comes the renewal of your dog's annual license and if you own a dog you are required to have a license for your dog. It is the law! The fine for a

dog with no license or failure to attach the dog license is \$50.00 in the City of North Vancouver. Because at Spot we take your dog out for a leash walk twice a day while he or she is with us, we would hate for you to get charged with a violation. Plus if your dog leaves your property or is lost and is discovered by someone else the license helps identify your dog so you can be contacted and hopefully get your dog back.
