Funds raised through **Paws for a Cause** stay in local communities to help animals in need. Support for **Paws for a Cause** helps the BC SPCA provide urgently needed care for thousands of animals each year.

In 2006 the BC SPCA:

- Conducted **5,805** cruelty investigations
- Removed **3,314** animals from dangerous or neglectful situations through cruelty investigations.
- Executed **104** warrants under the Criminal Code of Canada, the PCA Act and the Offense Act.
- Submitted **58** charges of animal cruelty and neglect to Crown Counsel.
- Operated **36** shelters/branches in communities throughout BC, including Wild ARC, a wildlife rehabilitation centre in Metchosin on Vancouver Island
- Rescued **49,126** domestic, farm and wild animals
- Reunited thousands of lost animals with their anxious families
- Found new, loving families for **22,548** homeless animals

- Rescued **1,711** deer, birds and other wildlife
- Offered humane education programs for **thousands of children in BC**, through the BC SPCA Kids Club, classroom and community presentations and the development of animal welfare curriculum materials for BC classrooms.

NEW STUFF at SPOTS SHOP

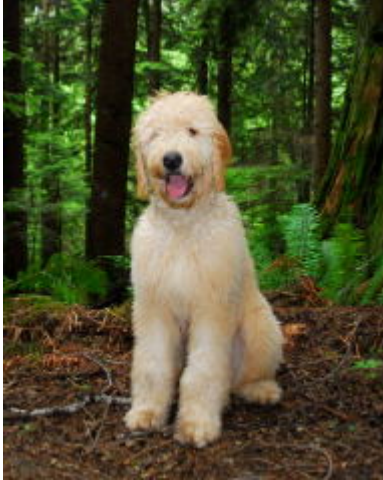
